FILMS FOR A NEW AGE

Two new 16 mm. color films from Hartley Productions have just been released. Ed Mitchell narrates them.

Inner Spaces surveys the latest work in psychic research: Douglas Dean's use of the plethysmograph to demonstrate telepathy; Ingo Swann demonstrating out-of-the body projection in the laboratory at American Society for Psychical Research; use of the computer to show how successful business executives use precognition to increase their profits.

But psychic functioning is only one part of our potential on the spectrum of consciousness. The Ultimate Mystery takes a wider view and asks, "What is consciousness?" Sequences in this film include the latest—and still unreported—work of polygraph expert Cleve Backster, who discovered primary perception in plants; a psychic healer and biochemist S. Justa Smith demonstrating in the lab that a healer's hands cause changes in the structure of enzymes; Dr. William McGarey of the A.R.E. Clinic in Phoenix performing acupuncture.

Inner Spaces runs 28 minutes; The Ultimate Mystery is 40 minutes long. Normally Inner Spaces rents for \$35 and sells for \$300 while The Ultimate Mystery rents for \$45 and sells for \$400. However, IONS members can rent them from Hartley Productions for \$30 and \$40 respectively if you identify yourself as a member. FILM ON URI GELLER AVAILABLE

When Ed Mitchell joined Dr. Harold Puthoff and Mr. Russell Targ in the laboratory at Stanford Research Institute last year to test Israeli psychic Uri Geller, a 16 mm. color film record of the work was kept. Now the film is available through IONS to universities and scientific research organizations. Entitled Experiments with Uri Geller, it runs 33 minutes and rents for \$35. No copies are being sold. A \$100 deposit is required, which will be returned upon receipt of the film at IONS.

In the film you'll see Uri demonstrate telepathy, clairvoyance and psychokinesis under strict controls. To rent a copy, send your name, address and two checks—one for \$35 and one for \$100—to the Film Bureau at IONS. Your organization's letterhead is required. Because of the limited number of copies and the high demand for the film, a three-day period is the maximum it can be booked for. Specify the three consecutive days you want and alternatives. Refund of deposit will be made upon return of film in satisfactory condition.

BOOK NOTES

IONS members and associates are often extremely productive in the literary field. Here are some of the latest books in noetics.

Patterns of Prophecy by Alan Vaughan (Hawthorn, 1973) is a survey of precognition, the ability to foretell the future beyond what one could reasonably expect from known trends or factors. Vaughan, editor of Psychic magazine, is himself precognitive.

Dream Telepathy by Montague Ullman, Stanley Krippner and Alan Vaughan, (Macmillan, 1973) reports the findings of ten years' work at Maimonides Medical Center, where Ullman and Krippner pioneered telepathic dream studies.

The Welcoming Silence by D. Scott Rogo (University Books, 1973) looks at the evidence of survival research and comes to the conclusion that there is a life beyond death.

Insights for the Age of Aquarius by Gina Cerminara (Prentice-Hall, 1973) uses the tools of General Semantic to analyze the problems of religion and to present a new conception of what worldwide religion at its best can be.
